Subject: Feedback on enrolment of DR TB patients on the regimens discontinued since the implementation of 'Guidelines for PMDT in India 2019 (Pre-final text) and Nikshay entries

Reference: 1. DO No. Z-28015/27/2012- TB (Part III) dated 09.03.2020

Dear All,

Since the implementation of Guidelines for PMDT in India- 2019, only two regimens are to be prescribed to treat all MDR/RR TB and XDR TB patients. Refer to the prior communications sent from CTD in this regard (DO No. Z-28015/27/2012- TB (Part III) dated 09.03.2020 & 21.01.2020). MDR/RR TB and XDR TB patients should be initiated on either Shorter MDR/RR TB regimen (standardized) or all oral longer M/XDR TB regimen (standardized/individualized based on DST pattern). As confirmed through weekly tracker sheet shared with all states, nationwide coverage of Guidelines for PMDT in India 2019 was achieved at the end of 1Q20.

State-wise status of MDR/RR TB patients enrolled on various regimens between 2Q-3Q2020 is attached herewith as Annexure 1 to enable you review the situation. It is observed that around 8% of MDR/RR TB and XDR TB patient were enrolled on regimen that are officially discontinued under NTEP i.e. conventional or DST guided regimens from the old 2017 version of the PMDT guidelines. Further, a decision has been made at CTD to remove the obsolete regimen options from drop down in the enrolment/episode creation section of NIKSHAY from 1st January 2021. This timeline is being kept to allow states and DR-TB centres concerned to complete the backlog data-entry of the patients who were enrolled on various regimen and not entered in the NIKSHAY.

You are therefore requested to take the following urgent actions:

- Analyse the various regimen prescribed by DR-TB centres in the state, review and communicate with the concerned Nodal/ District DRTB Centres to make sure that the older regimens are discontinued in practice and all MDR/ RR TB and XDR TB patients are initiated either on shorter MDR TB regimen or oral longer M/XDR TB regimen as appropriate as per current guidelines (2019) only.
- Review the status with Nodal/District DR-TB Centres as well as the districts, if any
 patients' data entries are pending or validate/correct the type of regimen of already
 enrolled DR TB patients in NIKSHAY to complete the data-entry of all DR-TB patients
 initiated on treatment by 31st December 2020.
- 3. Assign the State PMDT Coordinator/equivalent staff in State TB Cell/STDC, the responsibility to monitor and validate the data entry at the time of enrolment as well as follow up of all DR-TB patients and provides feedback to the respective districts or N/DDR-TBC on a monthly basis.

Please consider this as priority. Please take technical support from the WHO NTEP Medical Consultants and Regional Team Leads to assist you in the above actions required.
